SUBJECT: Use of T.C.S.U. Radios

EFFECTIVE DATE: August 31, 1994

The purpose of this procedure is to establish guidelines for the use of T.C.S.U. radios. These radios may be used for any departmental investigative purpose. T.C.S.U. target operations have priority over routine investigative cases in the use of T.C.S.U. equipment.

- I. To obtain the equipment, follow T.C.S.U. Procedure #4, Use of Equipment.
- II. T.C.S.U. operations shall be conducted exclusively on either the T.C.S.U. repeated frequency or the T.C.S.U. talk-around frequency.
 - A. Generally, when operating in a T.C.S.U. community, agents will have made prior notification to that community in accordance with T.C.S.U. Procedure #2.
 - B. These radios contain frequencies for non-T.C.S.U. communities as well.
 - 1. In the event you need to transmit on their frequency, you shall identify yourself as a T.C.S.U. agent using the radio number, i.e., "This is T.C.S.U.-5" and transmit your request in plain language.
- III. T.C.S.U. frequencies are <u>SECRET</u>. You shall make no effort to obtain these frequencies for any purpose without the prior approval of the TCSU Director.
